God's Spoke Word

As I was typing my journey with the Cancer Treatment Center of America on August 22, 2020, I was sitting at my dining room table at 5:20 pm when I heard the words, "I am visiting the iniquity of the third and fourth generations". When I searched the scripture, the words were found in Deuteronomy 5:9. The Holy Spirit led me to study what God was saying to me at this time.

What does Deuteronomy 5:9 say?

"Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, *visiting the iniquity of* the fathers upon *the children* unto *the third and fourth generation* of them that hate me (Deut. 5:9, KJV)" This statement from God comes right after the 1st ten commandments which states "Do not worship any other gods besides me"

What does this chapter represent?

It represents Moses second address to the children of Israel after leaving Egypt and providing them with the introduction to the law starting with the 10 Commandments. <u>The 10 Commandments are part of the principles for Godly living.</u>

10 Commandments


- 1. Do not worship any other gods besides me.
- 2. Do not make idols of any kind, whether in the shape of birds or animals or fish. You must never worship or bow down to them.
- 3. Do not misuse the name of the Lord your God.
- 4. Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
- 5. Honor your father and mother.
- 6. Do not murder.
- 7. Do not commit adultery.
- 8. Do not steal.
- 9. Do not testify falsely against your neighbor.
- 10.Do not covet your neighbor's wife. Do not covet your neighbor's house or land ...or anything else your neighbor owns. (Deut. 5:7-21)

What does the book represents as a whole?

Although the new living translation bible states the purpose of the book is to remind the people of what God had done and encourage them to rededicate their lives to him, this is true, but I personally see it as instructions from the Almighty God. The God I never knew but read about. I see it as redemption and restoration from being stolen and given an image and incorrect identity that was never meant to replace God. Over seven years ago, I was serving an image and not the true living God. Through Jesus Christ, God redeemed me to himself to be his people like many others that have been bought back by the blood of Jesus Christ. This is the love of God. He redeemed us from the curse through his son so that we can obey his laws, serve him and teach others to do the same. The curse at times looked like the blessing, and God had to awaken me to see the truth.

Where does this book take place and when?

The book takes place the Arabah in Moab, the eastside of the Jordan before they were to cross over the Jordan into the Promised Land. This is the same God today, but instead of the Jordan, we are crossing over a river of injustice to the Kingdom of God. We are crossing over from darkness to light.



How did God speak the words to me?

The word was quick and calm

Why did he say it to me, and what did he want me to do with the information today?

During my 44 years on earth, the Lord has been with me and provided for my every need so that I would lack nothing even though I was operating from a place of lack. God was hovering over me until the day of his call on January 14, 2013. This is the same God that spoke in Deut. 2:7 while the children of Israel wandered. God wants me to be obedient to his word. He wants me to write the vision that he is saying to me as a journal and revelatory knowledge of who he is in the earth today so when the manifestation of signs, miracles, wonders appear to the natural eyes the Almighty God will receive the Glory with Christ at the head of church, and the Holy Spirit as our guide. I am the third generation according to my bloodline along with my siblings, and

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God is here to manifest his glory in the 4th generation. The cancer in my body is a curse which is why the doctors haven't been able to find the source. God was very clear when he said he was visiting the sins of the fathers to the children in the 3rd and 4th generations. Every curse looks different, but the root is the same (Rebellion and false identity). In order to break the root cause of sins that kept me cycling around the same 8 mountains, I needed our savior to reverse the curse of sin to its root that it dries up and die to never produce fruit in our lives again. This is the Jesus Christ I serve. He freed us over 2000 years ago, and everyone operating in faith before me paved the way for us to see the day of the Lord. God is here to break the generational curse for us not to revert again and repeat the same actions that led to the curse for our children. The curse is broken. God did not blame me because I was born into iniquity. He knew me. Once he gave me his word in 2013, Christ helped me navigate through the darkness by the word because I finally believed. The word was a lamp to my feet. It was the mirror in darkness. It was like the moonlight walking on water in the dark on the surface of the waters.

Although cancer and other issues were a curse that was placed on me in "My Egypt" (land of bondage and oppression), the blessings and promises of God were always with me. There was a spirit of bondage blocking the God in me, and if I did not activate the promises of God in 2013 by believing in Jesus Christ as my Lord and savior, the trials, tribulation including cancer would have overtaken my body. God promised healing of sickness through his son Jesus Christ. He promised us the ability to get wealth. He promised that if we renewed our mind and let this mind be in us that was also in Christ Jesus that we would be saved. We would live an abundant life. We would take back what the enemy stole. We are the head and not tall. We are above and not beneath. We have the power to tread on every scorpion. The weapons formed, but they did not prosper. The sickness was not unto death, but the glory of God.

God showed me the book of Deuteronomy because my life is being rededicated back to his work and before I enter the Promised Land, he wants me to understand his laws and commandments. He is the author and finisher of my faith. He wants me to understand the grace that was upon my life to get me to the expected end which is his glory. According to Deut. 4:44-49, "This is the body of instruction that Moses presented to the Israelites. These are the laws, decrees, and regulations that Moses gave to the people of Israel when they left Egypt, 46 and as they camped in the valley near Bethpeor east of the Jordan River. (This land was formerly occupied by the Amorites under King Sihon, who ruled from Heshbon. But Moses and the Israelites destroyed him and his people when they came up from Egypt. Israel took possession of his land and that of King Og of Bashan—the two Amorite kings east of the Jordan. 48 So Israel conquered the entire area from Aroer at the edge of the Arnon Gorge all the way to Mount Sirion, also called Mount Hermon. 49 And they conquered the eastern bank of the Jordan River as far south as the Dead Sea,[b] below the slopes of Pisgah." (NLT).

We are Crossing Over into the Promised Land

The sin in this land has reached its full measure just like God told Abraham in Genesis 15:16, "In the fourth generation your descendants will come back here, for the sin of the Amorites has not yet reached its full measure (NIV)". God wanted me to know that his people are getting ready to cross over into the Promised Land, and we can't keep doing the same thing in our Egypt and expect God to bless us. What I was serving was

not God prior to 2013. I was serving an image and denying the true power of the Lord. I was awakened to put away all sin and go through a sanctification, purging process to remove the sin off my life such as slandering, strife, sexual immorality, fornication, gossiping, adultery and idol worshipping. These were fruits from the root of rebellion. I kept cycling these mountains until the last of them were all broken as of 8/23/2020. Prior to 2013, I did not know who I was, and I was conforming to the image of the world, but it was salvation/baptism in 1987 that pulled me back into alignment with God. When Christ snatched me out of darkness, it was a death, burial and now a resurrection to help others get into the Kingdom of God.

God showed me that with all the battles his people have endured, he has gone before us and laid a foundation, so we do not have a reason to worry or be afraid. He will fight for us as he did for Israel in Deut. 1:29. When God spoke to me on January 14, 2013 and said, "The battle is not yours, its mine". I expected him to do something at that moment because I had been wronged. No, that was not the case. He spoke to me from a time that had not arrive. The blessing was there, but I was not ready for what God was ready to do in my life so it took 7 years to strip me naked to where I had to depend solely on him for answers even when I tried to reach out to others to help me understand the revelation. God kept me in the cleft of the rock protected with his word. I AM is here now and he is walking in the Garden amongst us. It's 7 years, but I made it through the wilderness, and I am crossing over to the Promised Land, but no one should be left behind. I pray for God to resurrect his people and give them ears to hear, sight to see and a mouth to speak thus says the Lord. God is making a way in the wilderness and he will prepare a table in the presence of our enemies. All we need to do is pray, be still, watch, and wait.

Between 500 and 700 years after God spoke his promises to Abraham in Genesis 15, he specifically said that his descendants will possess the land when the sin of the Amorites is full according to Gen. 15:16. During Moses 1st address to Israel in the land of Moab east of the Jordan river (Deut. 1:5), he gave them the following instructions because God had already told Moses he wasn't going into the Promised Land. He gave the people the following instructions:

- 1. He explained the law to Israel (Deut. 1:5, NLT).
- 2. It's time to break camp. We have been at this mountain long enough (Deut 1:7, NLT)
- 3. Choose men from each tribe who have wisdom, understanding and a good reputation (Deut 1:7, NLT).
 - a. The instructions he gave to leaders were:
 - i. "At that time I instructed the judges, 'You must hear the cases of your fellow Israelites and the foreigners living among you. Be perfectly fair in your decisions 17 and impartial in your judgments. Hear the cases of those who are poor as well as those who are rich. Don't be afraid of anyone's anger, for the decision you make is God's decision. Bring me

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any cases that are too difficult for you, and I will handle them.'18 "At that time I gave you instructions about everything you were to do. (Deut. 1:16-18, NLT).

Revelation of New Birth Missionary Baptist Church

As God sent me through a reflection of his word, he sent me back to the purpose of why I was a member for 13 years at New Birth Missionary Baptist Church. The late Bishop Eddie L. Long was like Moses to me, but the late Dr. Martin Luther King was also like Moses for the world, and Dr. Myles Munroe can also be compared to the Moses of our times. Neither of them made it to the physical Promise Land, but they saw it and spoke about what so they could ensure their congregation and children reached that place of glory. They knew they would not get they're with us, but they provided everything God gave them to speak into the earth. The late Bishop Eddie L. Long managed his assignment well from heaven to plant the seed that is producing a harvest of souls as I type. He pointed people to Christ in the congregation and not his flesh. No matter what happened in his life, he kept preaching the word. That was his calling. Like Moses chose Joshua to lead the people, Bishop chose Bishop Stephen A. Davis to reside as pastor in 2017 who was like a Joshua to me. According to what the spirit showed me at the time as I saw this happen, my spirit was like Caleb. Caleb had a different spirit (Numbers 14:24-38). I asked questions because I wanted to know why I was not experiencing the manifestation of God in the church. One of the leaders responded and said, "Grace". I can also remember when a young lady sat down in my office in 2013 and told me, "You have a different spirit, like Caleb". I didn't receive it at the time because I was going through so much at the job until I felt my different spirit did not make a difference because I stood up for righteousness on the job. I kept hearing the same thing from others who said I had a different spirit, but I just ignored what they were saying because I couldn't comprehend. My mind was still carnal. I didn't have an ear to hear what the spirit was saying to the church that was within me (Revelation 2:29). But as time progressed, God began to unveil what he wanted to show me for my life.

I have a Dream Revelation

I remember when my job dismissed me from employment, there were areas that God said not to pursue. When he showed me when to pursue and when not to pursue, it reminded me of when Dr. Martin Luther King "paused the marchers and led them in prayer, whereupon the troopers stepped aside. King then turned the protesters around, believing that the troopers were trying to create an opportunity that would allow them to enforce a federal injunction prohibiting the march. This decision led to criticism from some marchers, who called King cowardly" (1). This decision was Dr. Martin Luther King's calling on the Lord for help, and the answer was for him to turn around. This is the act of repentance by listening to the Holy Spirit to bring peace instead of strife. Peace is the fruit of the spirit as explained in Galatians 5:22-25 which is the foundation as to why Dr. Martin Luther King believed in non-violence. He embodied the fruit of the spirit as he walked this earth which means that everything he did was for the Kingdom of God.

He heard a word from the Lord to not pursue. His obedience is what saved his life and others to birth the Civil Rights Act of 1964. God pointed me to the scripture Deut. 1:42 and showed me that when he says do not purse, that's what he means or the people against you will overtake you because he provided strict instructions not to pursue. I thank God that Dr. Martin Luther King had an ear to hear what the spirit was saying to him. When Dr. Martin Luther King kneeled, he was given honor to the Almighty God and the battle he was fighting became God's. Now I understand today, why God spoke the words, "the battle is not yours, it's mine" to me on January 14, 2013 when my rights were clearly violated as an African American female in the workplace with no regard to the law. I was dismissed and forgotten as if it never happened, but God saw every step of injustice that was made against me. My dismissal from work became my cross that I didn't think I could bare, but with the help of Christ I got through the 7year challenge. I thank God for pastors like the late Dr. Martin Luther King who spoke the truth in the face of adversity. His speech on August 28, 1963 will mark 57 years this year. He saw the vision of the Kingdom of God 57 years ago. The late Bishop Long saw the vision over 30 years and Dr. Myles Munroe saw the vision his entire life which was around 60 years. The power and the knowledge that these men had on earth was powerful and revelatory knowledge of a round about timeframe of God's glory. John Lewis's death was another sign that the Lord is close at hand along with Elijah Cumming and many other men or black lives that have been lost or taken to soon. I thank God for these men and many others that paved the way to ensure our liberty and freedom to expose the system of injustice where its eyes were blind, mouth mute, ears deaf, and heart's hardened towards true justice. We are about to see a demonstration of the power of who Christ is in the earth and he is about to fulfill what the scripture already says, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free (Luke 4:18, NLT)" as prophesied in Isaiah 61:1 and spoke by Jesus himself in Luke 4:18. This is for the people of God, but it will reign on the just and unjust according to Matthew 5:45.

I give a special thanks to the pastors, theologians, the civil rights leaders, advocates and everyone that has a cause for the spoken word of God or to get God's people where they need to be for this next shift in leadership. God is the living water that Jesus spoke about with the Samaritan woman (John 4) that gives life more abundantly. When we connect with God through our own narrow path with Jesus Christ, blind eyes will open, deaf ears will hear, and mute mouths will speak.
