Title: The “Let the Anointing Flow” -

Scriptures: Psalms 133:2; Luke 7:36-50; Leviticus 8:12, 1 Samuel 16:1-13; Matthew 9:18-22

Background: This bible study was birthed on 1/25/2020 after listening to Shaneika Byars YouTube message called “3rd Dimension” - https://youtu.be/jUF5_6vm6xQ. Thank you Shaneika. She confirmed what was already in my spirit. She stated to read Psalms 133:2. I needed to search the scriptures to understand more of what the Lord was telling me about my anointing.

Purpose: There purpose is to provide a place holder for God, Christ and the Holy Spirit’s return for the restoration of God’s Kingdom.

Questions: There are 4 questions that rose up out of this bible study which are after the highlighted scripture below.

Highlighted Scripture: As I read Psalms, the Holy Spirit revealed the words that are in bold as I read (Psalms 133:2, NIV).

For harmony is as precious as the fragrant anointing oil

Like the woman that poured oil on Jesus feet with the alabaster box
(Luke 7:36-50)

That was poured over Aaron’s head, that ran down his beard

Like Samuel Anointed David to be King
(1 Samuel 16:1-13)

Like the Holy Spirit anointed Jesus to preach the gospel (Luke 4:18)

And onto the border of his robe.

Like Jesus when the women with the issue of blood touched the hem of his garment. Matthew 9:18-22

1. How does my (your) life relate to the woman “No Name” with the Alabaster Jar?

Luke 7:36-50

When Jesus by his spirit showed me the sin I did before him and God, they were many. I cried many tears each time knowing I did it in his presence. There were many nights that I cried. The tears cleansed me of what I did at Jesus feet. Jesus was the one interceding for my sin. He was the one that drew me out of the water. I wasn't pure enough to touch his hem because I did not know the true Jesus Christ and I did not know how to turn away. The sins were like addictions that I could not control without help. I had to walk through steps of repentance to return to a rightful position with God. The woman was worshiping Jesus and honoring him because she knew he was the savior for her sinful acts. She knew she was a sinner. The pharisees knew she was a sinner, but what did they do to bring her closer to God. Nothing, but talk about how sinful she was instead of helping her follow the laws of God. When I tried to find help for my sin through the church, I would get the words, “we all sin and fall short of God's glory”. This is religion. I had to take the boundaries of religion and apply the word of God in my life to break out the alabaster box that it put me in. I was in the alabaster box with my oil coming out because I didn't know Jesus was present. Religion points fingers, places blame, discuss how much of a sinner we are, but the Kingdom prepares, cleans,

purges, push out the bad to make room for the good fruit and positioned me to meet Christ with a humble heart because he freed me from my sin nature. He delivered me on 1/25/2020 when this scripture and teaching dropped into my spirit. Jesus not only **forgave** me of my sins, he has **cancelled my debt, my faith saved me** from destruction, and I will **walk in peace**. I will be healed as I walked out the promise. This is how my life reflected the woman with the Alabaster Jar. I am no longer in the box that man created for me. I am outside the box producing the oil to walk with Jesus Christ as his servant.

2. How does my (Your) life remind me (You) of Aaron, David and the Holy Spirit? Leviticus 8:12; 1 Samuel 16:1-13; Luke 4:18

Moses anointed Aaron making him Holy for his work (Leviticus 8:12).

Aaron's anointing was on his head representing leadership, David's anointing was on his head by the prophet Samuel representing a kingship anointing for the purpose of God, Jesus was anointed by the Holy Spirit for God's work to reign over his Kingdom. Jesus's anointing was in him which was also on his garment.

God has chosen me, but Jesus Christ has prepared me, and the Holy Spirit has guided me for my assignment. No one personally placed oil on my head other than when the late Bishop L. Long prayed over me and touched me in 2013 with anointing oil and stated, "I would break the curse on my bloodline". That sounded good at the time, but my walk with Christ has not been a bed of roses. It has been a hard journey, but every step is worth it knowing that I have everlasting life in the Kingdom of God. My walk with Jesus Christ through the process of repentance, salvation, redemption, and purification has set me apart for God's will for my life. It was the process

that pressed out my oil for the anointing that is currently on my life.

God provides me with instructions like he did his priests and kings along with the Holy Spirit's guidance. I can't do anything without the Holy Spirit's guidance. Every story in the bible has 2 people involved in the book. One had to be like Jesus and the other had to be like the Holy Spirit to get things done while operating on God's instructions. Christ, God and the Holy Spirit work together. To give a better example that you are hearing from all three. When you hear the word spoken to you audibly or the still small voice, write it down. Does it align with scripture? Find it. Read it and meditate on what the word is saying. Christ will walk you through the earthly process and be with you. The Holy Spirit will guide you through your studying and meditation. All these steps are your assignment and God's will for your life. If it does not align with scripture, it is not God. God will always give you confirmation. Wait on him.

3. How does my (your) life remind me (you) of the collar of Aarons robe and touching the hem of Jesus robe?
Matthew 9:18-22

The collar of Aarons robe reminded me of how he was the first to be anointed to help lead God's people. This shows leadership, headship and God's chosen. I will be the first to speak the words that God is saying for his Kingdom. I will be the first that is like Aaron with a direct connection with God, Christ and the Holy Spirit. I touched Jesus through my faith. I believe. I studied for years without understanding, but I kept doing it until a light came on in 2003. That light would go in/out, but nevertheless I was touching Jesus until he walked me through the process to

become a disciple for him. It is never a question in your mind if you are walking with Jesus Christ. He will let himself be known to you. You will know.

4. How do I(you) relate to the “No Name” Women in the Bible? These are the words that came to me during this study lesson:

- a. Your faith has made you whole; Woman with the issue of blood
(Luke 8:43-48)
- b. Go, and Sin No More; Woman caught in the act of adultery
(John 8:1-11)
- c. Tell everyone who told you everything about your life; Woman at the well (John 4)
- d. Your faith has healed you; you are forgiven; go and sin no more and receive this anointing for your life; Woman with the alabaster box
(Luke 7:37-50)
- e. Do business for me until I return, Virtuous Woman
(Proverbs 31)

Also, as it relates to the “No name” women in the bible that were not mentioned have a purpose in mind by God at an appointed time. One of the purposes is for the oil to get out of the box to serve Jesus with your life “Woman of God”. Putting oil on a person is one thing, but the oil getting into the body for the purpose of healing is another process. The ‘no name’ women represented reversing the curse through her faith in Jesus Christ so the Kingdom can be birthed through the guidance of the Holy Spirit. God will appoint and name the women that ran their race and stayed in their lane because she would have completely reversed her life through the teachings of Jesus Christ. Not naming the woman was God’s design so his will would be fulfilled on earth as it is in heaven for man and woman. Not naming the woman places

her faith on display and not her name and title. His actions are examples of the power of Jesus Christ in a believers life because we must come out of sin for the blessings to flow from God. We must come out of our emotions and operate from the Holy Spirt. Just like God made 2 in his image at the beginning, male and female. The anointing that fell on Aaron and David will reverse and come through a woman like it did with Mary & Elizabeth to fulfill his vision, but this woman is a sinner turned around to serve and worship Jesus. The woman will reverse what happened in the garden with Eve, and not fall for the serpent's tests of lust, pride and power. She will live by the words that come out of the mouth of God. Instead of her giving in to these temptations, she will resist the enemy and he will flee. Flee can look like divorce, dismissal from a job, sickness and other steps of faith that look like death. It is only an appearance if you are walking with God. It is only a shadow of death. Read Psalms 23 when caught in these situations, it will comfort you in the midst of the storm.

What is different about this woman of God is she is purified before God. She hungers for God. She thirsts after God. She feeds on God's every word and know he is going to deliver his promise no matter what circumstances she has found herself. She seeks after his face. She wants to see his glory manifested in the earth. God sent her a word and he will look over his word to make sure it is performed (Jeremiah 1:12). God has switched his hand (Genesis 48:14-20). This will bring the women in alignment to walk into the Kingdom of God from coming out of the box or helping other come out the box to serve Jesus Christ because God has blessed us. Then your Boaz will see you. You can't have a Boaz without following in the steps of the Redeemer. Boaz in the bible redeemed Ruth based on conditions. She also had to line up with the character that God was expecting if Boaz was to redeem her. That's another lesson or book to be written.

Your Boaz should reflect the unchanging word of God but pushed you to be the change. She is returning to her first love with Jesus Christ, her Lord and Savior.
